Jerry & Tina Grandey's \$1 million donation will help build the bears a new home!

Join Us in Building Koda & Mistaya a New and Larger Home.

Since arriving in 2008, grizzly bears Mistaya and Koda have called the Kinsmen Bear Exhibit home. It's a wonderful habitat, great when the bears were smaller but too small for two full-grown, 350-kilo grizzlies.

Now, thanks to an amazing \$1 million donation from long-time zoo supporters Jerry and Tina Grandey, plans are officially underway to build the bears a larger, more natural habitat.







The Bear Necessities

The Grandey donation brings us a giant step closer to building a new home for Koda and Mistaya. The grizzly brothers (by different mothers) were orphaned as cubs and came to the zoo when they were only a few years old. As you can see, they are thriving—taking dips in their pool, soaking up the sun on their favourite rocks and now taking a long, long winter nap in their dens.

The Zoo is currently working to develop detailed design specifications and construction estimates for the new habitat. It will be significantly larger and feature climbing structures, resting and sleeping locations, foraging opportunities, safe retreats, natural vegetation and soils, water features and more.

BHP ENCHANTED FOREST CELEBRATES 25 YEARS

One of Canada's longest-running holiday light shows is on now! Don't miss the 2023-2024 BHP Enchanted Forest at the Saskatoon Forestry Farm Park.

The 25th anniversary event opened with two nights of walking tours, hosting close to 19,000 walkers. The official drive-thru started November 18th.

There's even more dazzle this year thanks to the addition of three new light displays—a spectacular Globe that weighs over 37,000 pounds, a 75-foot tunnel of 37,000 lights and a series of "prairie portraits" representing iconic Saskatchewan scenes. The display route is longer too, at 2.5 kilometres.

The BHP Enchanted Forest runs through January 7th. Gates are open 5:30-10:00 pm every night, including Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.

* Car passes are available at Saskatoon Shoppers Drug Marts and Saskatoon Co-op Food Stores and Gas Bars plus Warman, Martensville and Watrous or at the gate. Admission at the gate is \$10 per person or \$35 per car (up to 7 people). Proceeds support the Saskatoon Zoo Foundation and Saskatoon City Hospital Foundation.
